



PEER PROFESSIONALS IN CORRECTIONAL / JUSTICE SETTINGS: CRIMINAL JUSTICE SUPPORTED RECOVERY (CJSR)

This course explores how substance use disorders intersect with justice involvement, challenges of correctional systems, and the importance of trauma-responsive, person-centered, recovery-oriented approaches. It emphasizes the role of peer professionals, advocacy, harm reduction, accountability, ethical practice, and navigating within justice settings.

We will discuss strategies for reducing stigma, supporting reentry, collaborating effectively with justice actors, and applying tools such as motivational interviewing, the stages of change, and recovery coaching.

We also address peer wellness, self-care, supervision needs, and ASAP-NYCB Criminal Justice Supported Recovery certification.
