

Criminal Justice Support Recovery (CJSR) Renewal Training

THIS 6-HOUR TRAINING WILL PROVIDE THE KEY COMPONENTS FOR ADVOCATING FOR YOUR PARTICIPANTS IN BOTH THE COURT AND CORRECTIONAL SETTINGS. WE WILL DEFINE AND EXPLORE ADVOCACY AND TYPES OF ADVOCACY; EXPLORE THE PEER ROLE AS ADVOCATES IN THESE SETTINGS; APPLY LIVED EXPERIENCE TO STRATEGICALLY ADVOCATE FOR BOTH THE INDIVIDUAL AND FOR SYSTEMS CHANGE. PARTICIPANTS WILL CREATE AND PRACTICE THEIR ADVOCACY STORY AS A JUSTICE PEER ADVOCATE AND OBTAIN INFORMATION ON KEY LANGUAGE AND ACRONYMS FOUND ACROSS THESE SETTINGS. FINALLY, PARTICIPANTS WILL LEARN HOW TO CULTIVATE ALLIES FOR ENHANCING THE CORRECTIONS/COURT SYSTEM TOWARDS A MORE RECOVERY-ORIENTED SYSTEM OF CARE.
